For example, all survey participants were asked if they had diabetes, but only those who answered yes were asked if they use insulin. If a dimension value is unknown for a particular survey record, that record will not be included in the counts for that particular dimension.

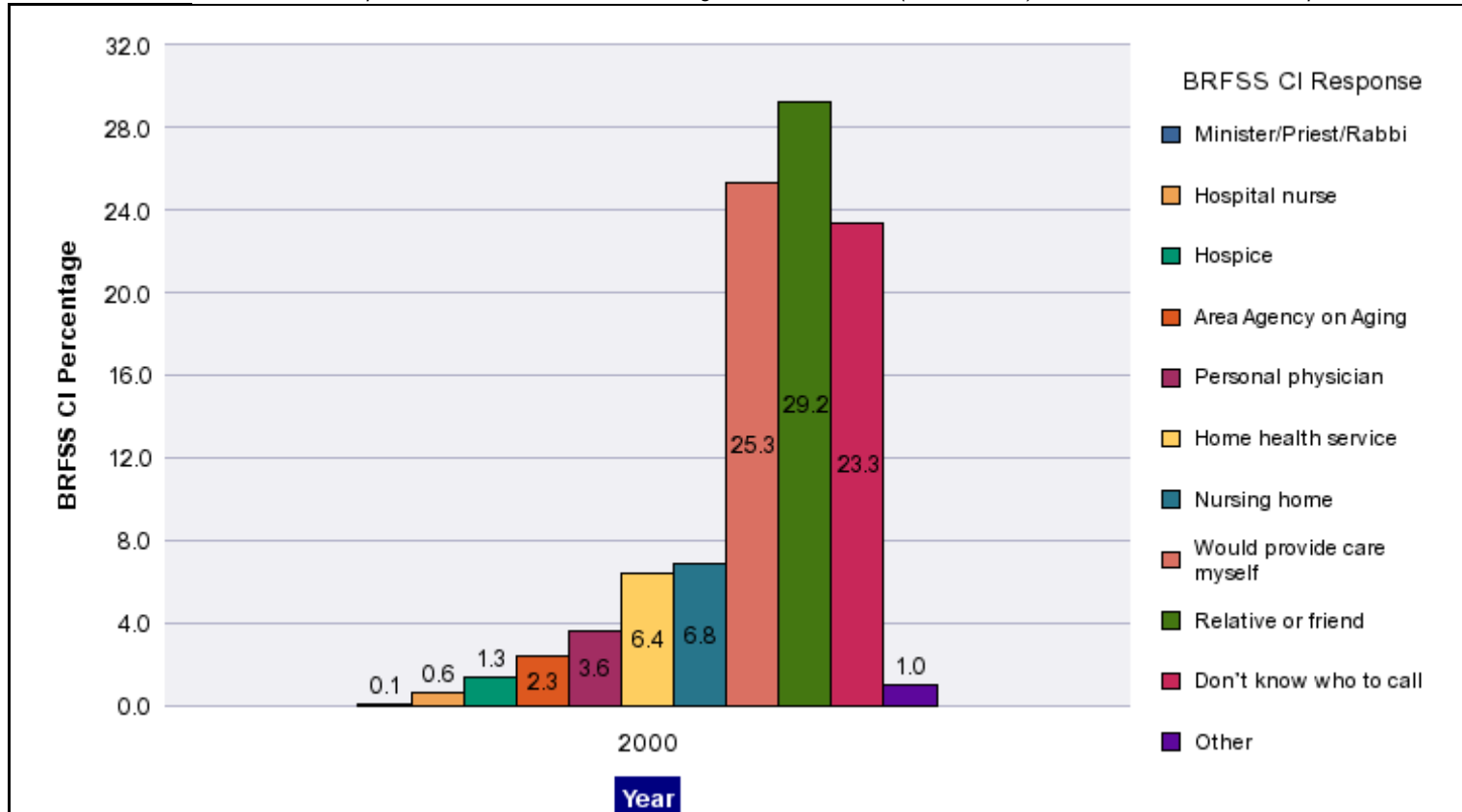
