For most questions the estimated adult population will be the entire adult population. For some secondary questions only a subset of the population was asked the question. For example, all survey participants were asked if they had diabetes, but only those who answered yes were asked if they use insulin. If a dimension value is unknown for a particular survey record, that record will not be included in the counts for that particular dimension.

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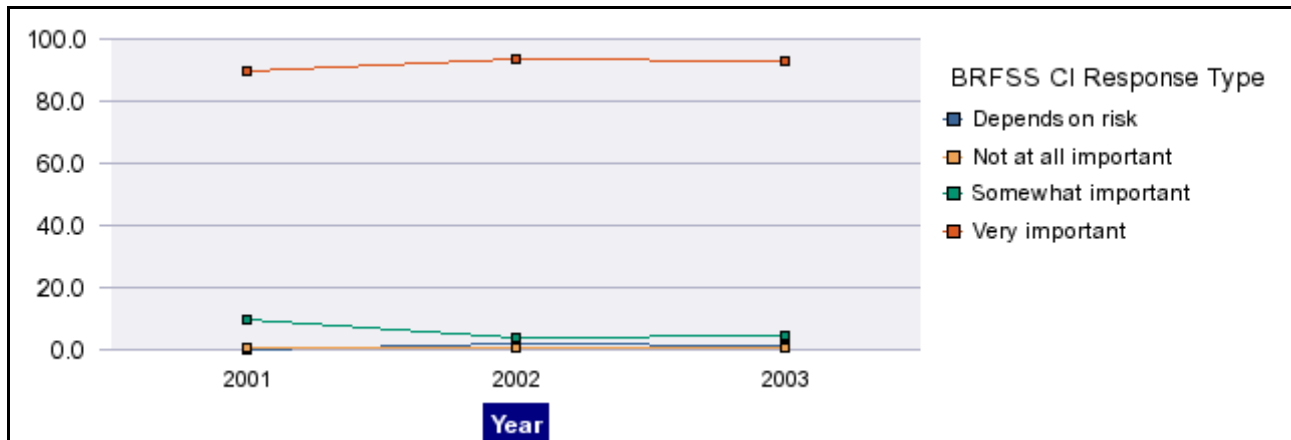
