The trend analysis report shows the trend for the selected health variable over selected years in a table and a graph. Due to the addition of cell phones to the survey and changes in the weighting methodology, results from 2011 and forward cannot be trended with data from prior years. Estimated Population: This number is a weighted representation of the population who responded to a particular question in the survey. For most questions the eligible population will be the entire adult population. For some secondary questions only a subset of the population was asked the question. For example, all survey participants were asked if they had diabetes, but only those who answered yes were asked if they use insulin. If a dimension value is unknown for a particular survey record, that record will not be included in the counts for that particular dimension.

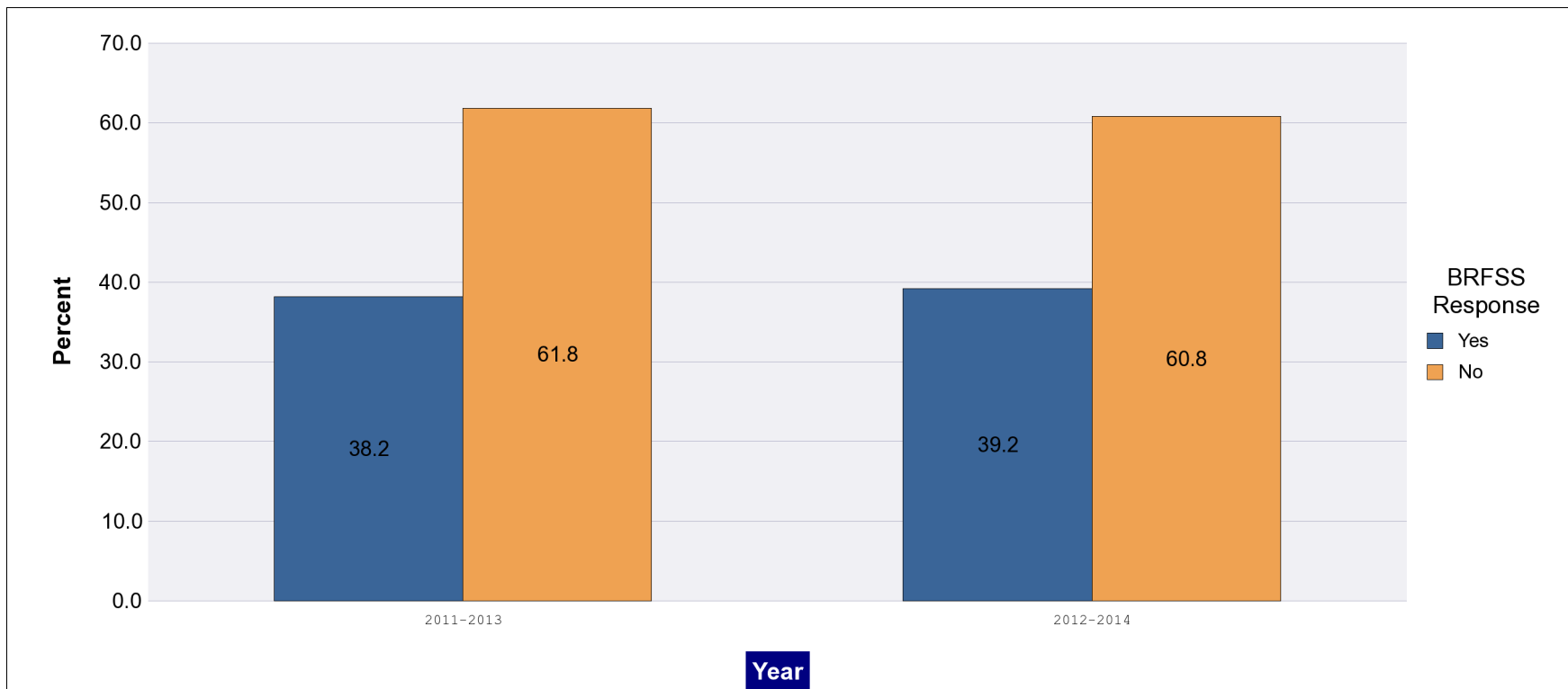
