For example, all survey participants were asked if they had diabetes, but only those who answered yes were asked if they use insulin.

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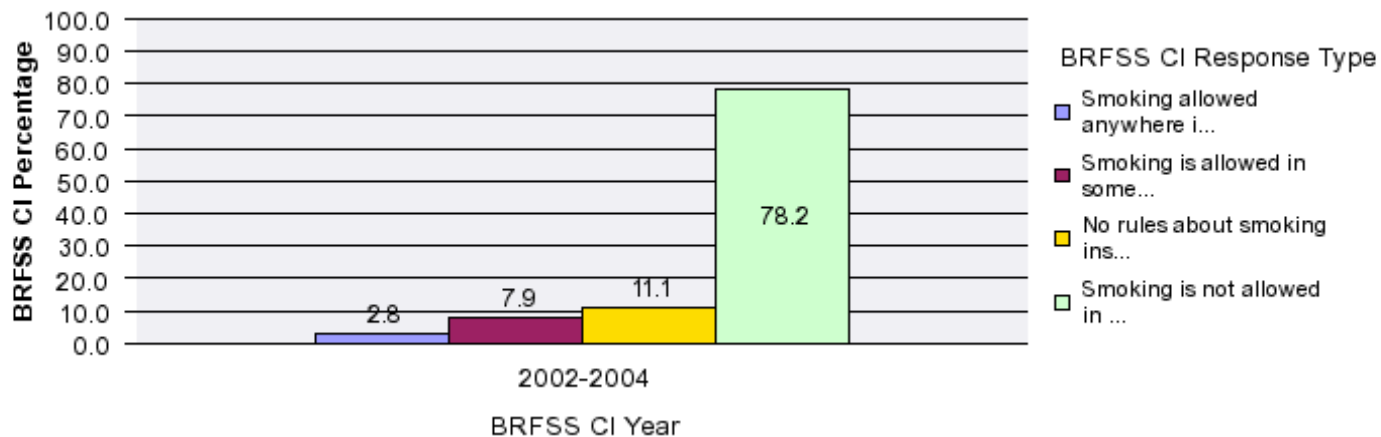
