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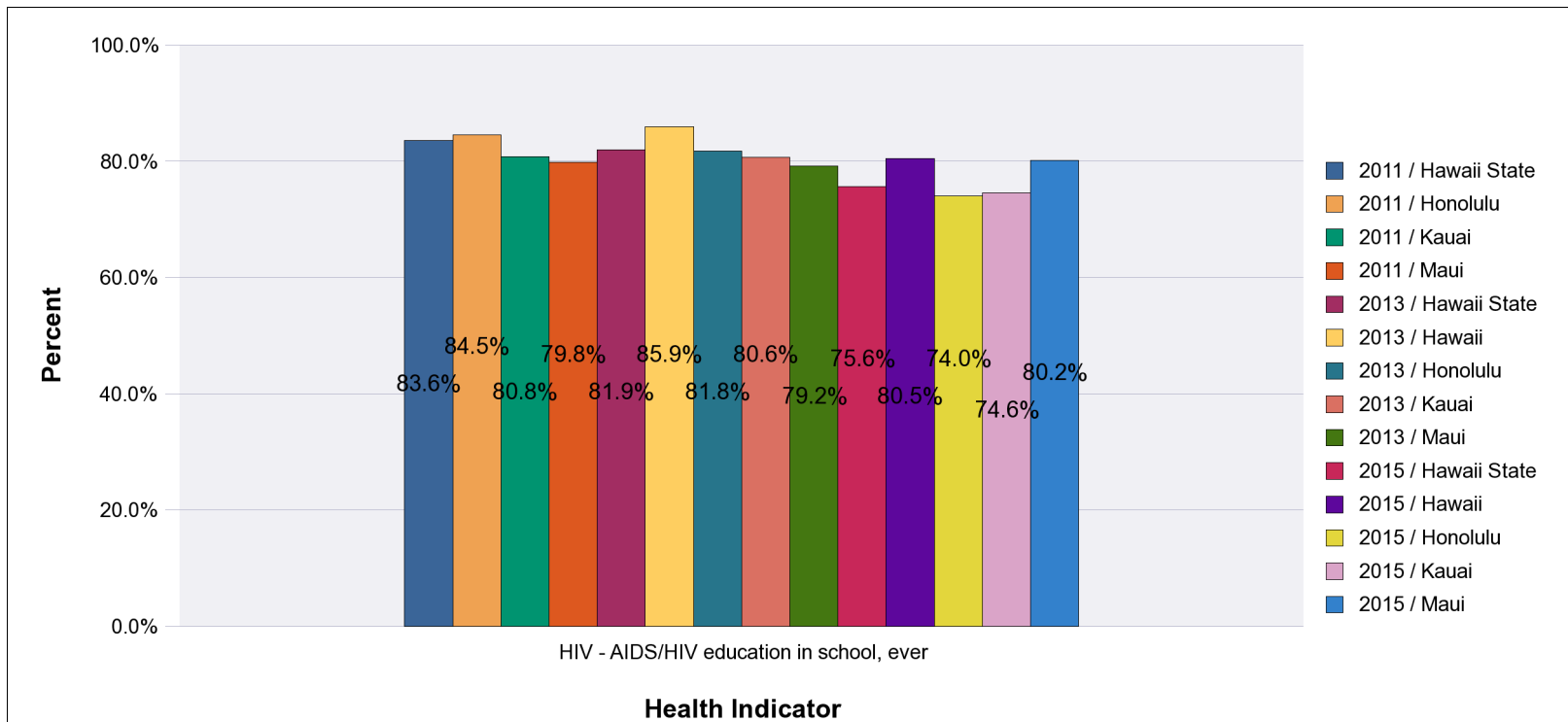

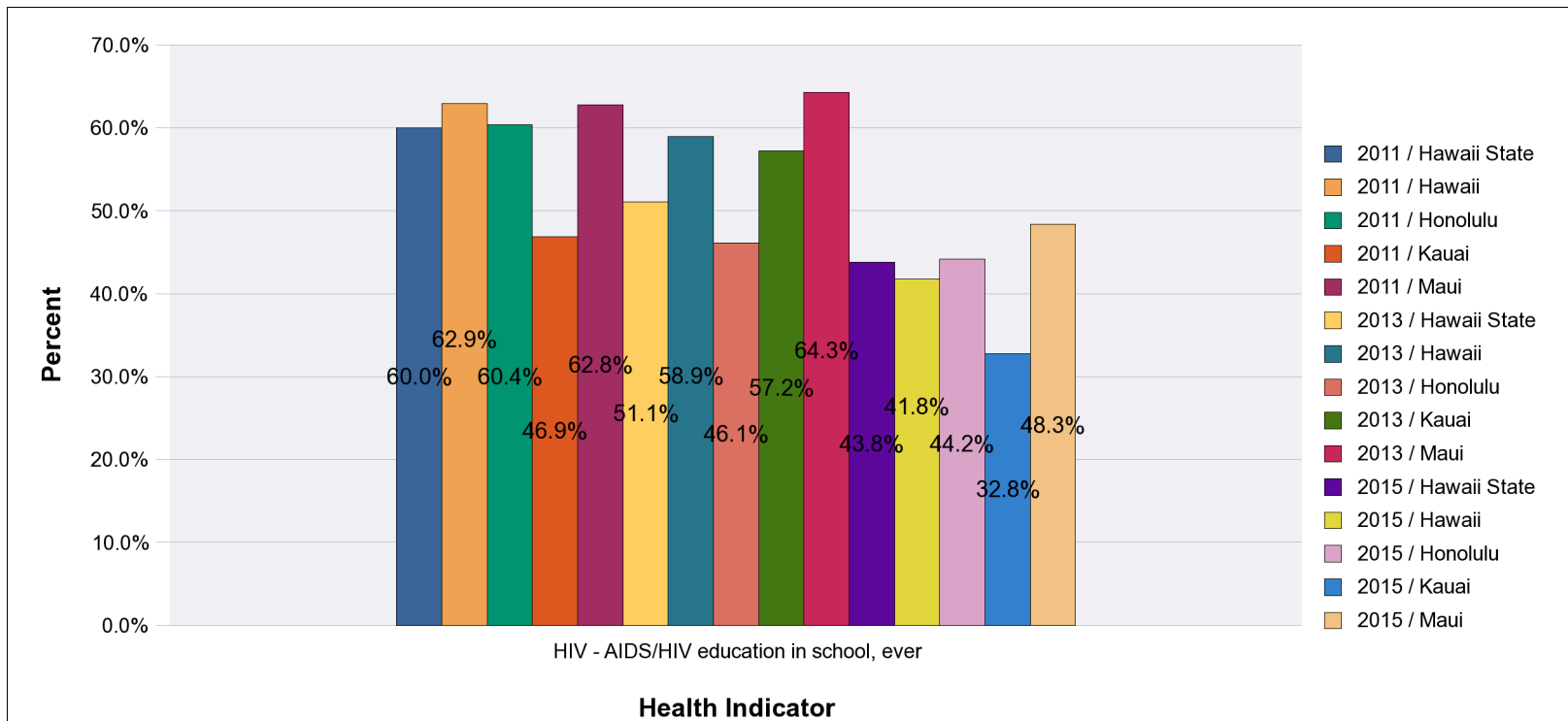


HIV/AIDS Awareness in Hawaii, by School Type, by State and County, for the Years 2011 - 2015
