If a dimension value is unknown for a particular survey record, that record will not be included in the counts for that particular dimension.

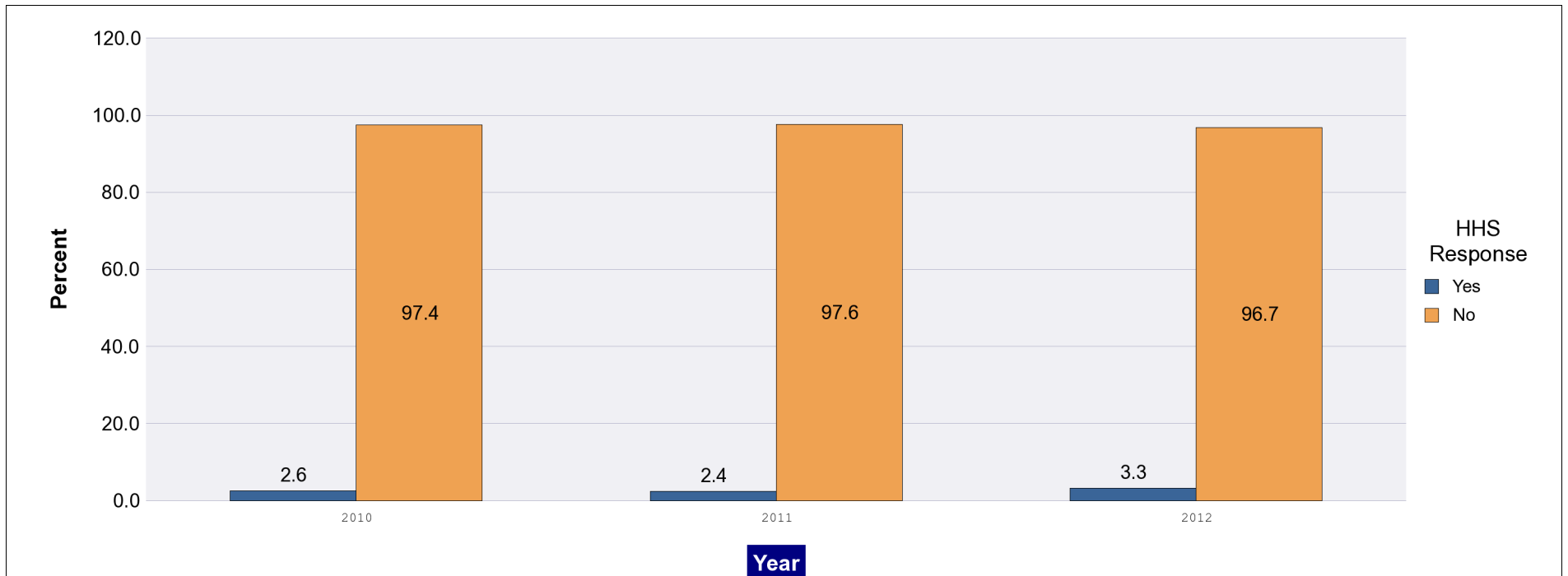
