Death Counts and Fetal Death Rates for the State of Hawaii (Residents Only), by State, Mother's County of Residence, Mother's DOH Race-Ethnicity, and Mother's Age, for the Years 2000-2013

This report displays the number of fetal deaths and the fetal death rate for Hawaii residents. A fetal death is the spontaneous intrauterine death of a fetus at any time during pregnancy. The Fetal Death Rate is the number of fetal deaths per 1,000 live births and fetal deaths. Data are shown by year, in descending order. The data are displayed by selected dimensions and attributes. If a dimension or attribute value is unknown for a particular record, that record will not be included in the counts for that particular dimension.
