*This report displays the number of deaths and mortality rate for sudden unexpected infant death (ICD-10 codes: R95 (SIDS), R99 (Unknown Cause), and W75 (Accidental Suffocation and Strangulation in Bed) for infants under 1 year of age. The mortality rate is the number of infant deaths per 1,000 live births. Data are shown by year, in descending order. The data are displayed by selected dimensions and attributes. If a dimension or attribute value is unknown for a particular record, that record will not be included in the counts for that particular dimension.*
