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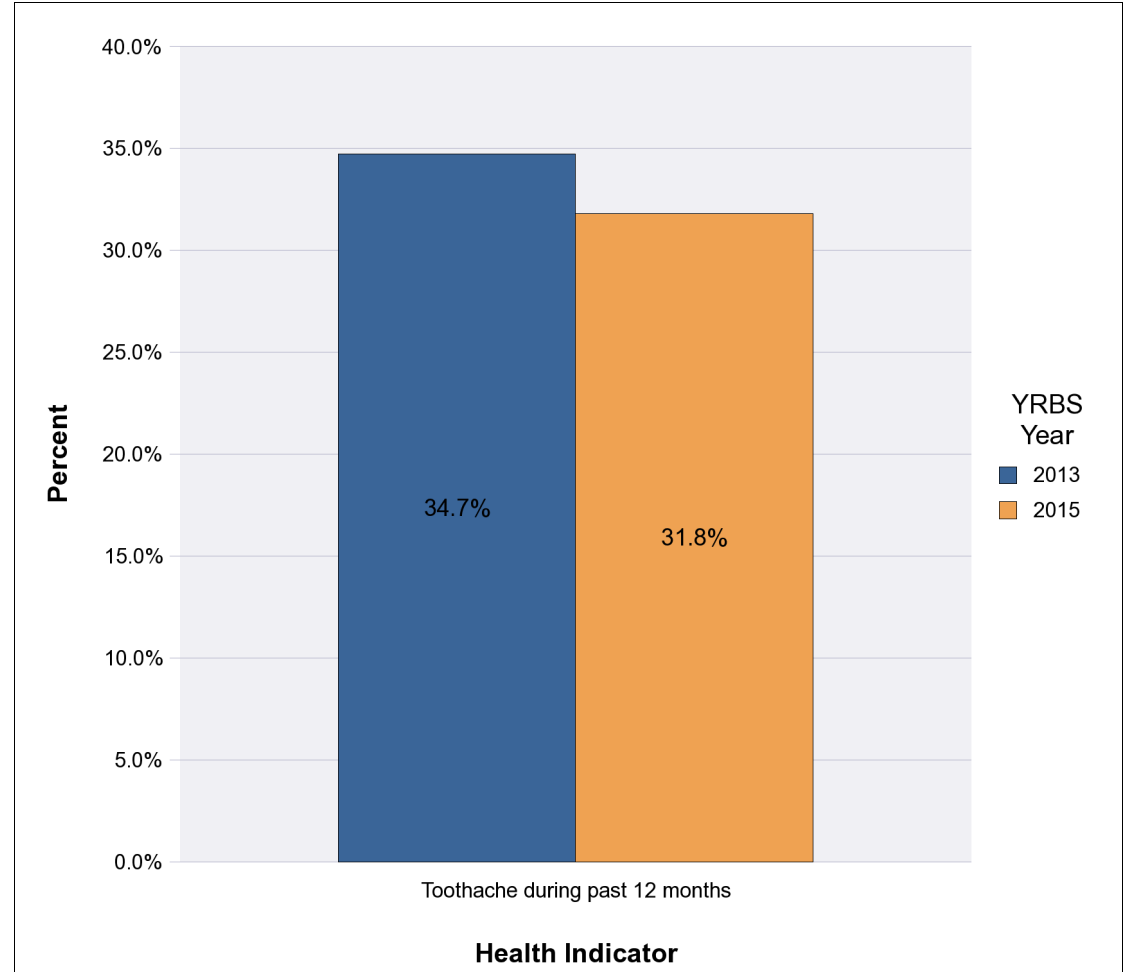

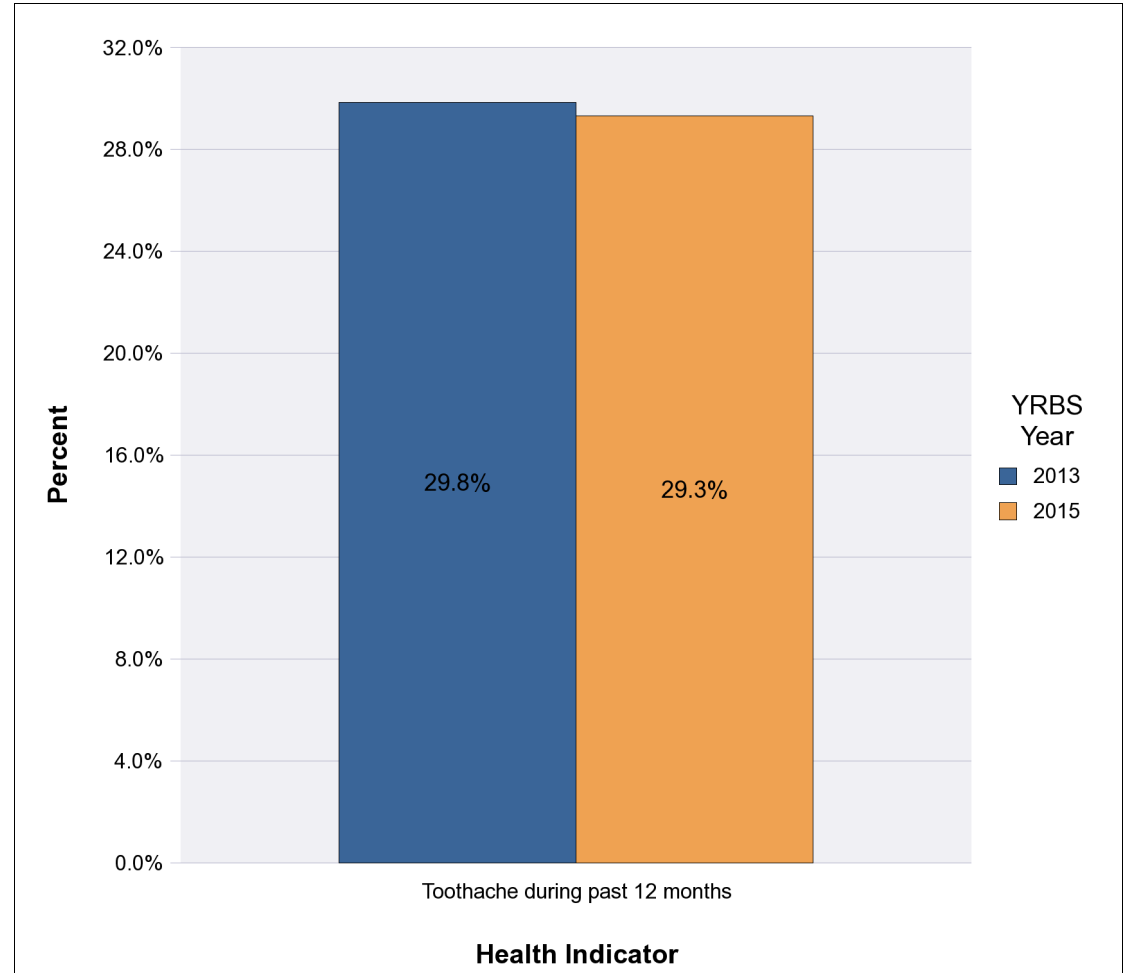


Toothache in Hawaii, by School Type, for the Years 2013 - 2015
