Smoke cigarettes - frequent (Youth)	Students who smoked cigarettes on 20 or more of the past 30 days

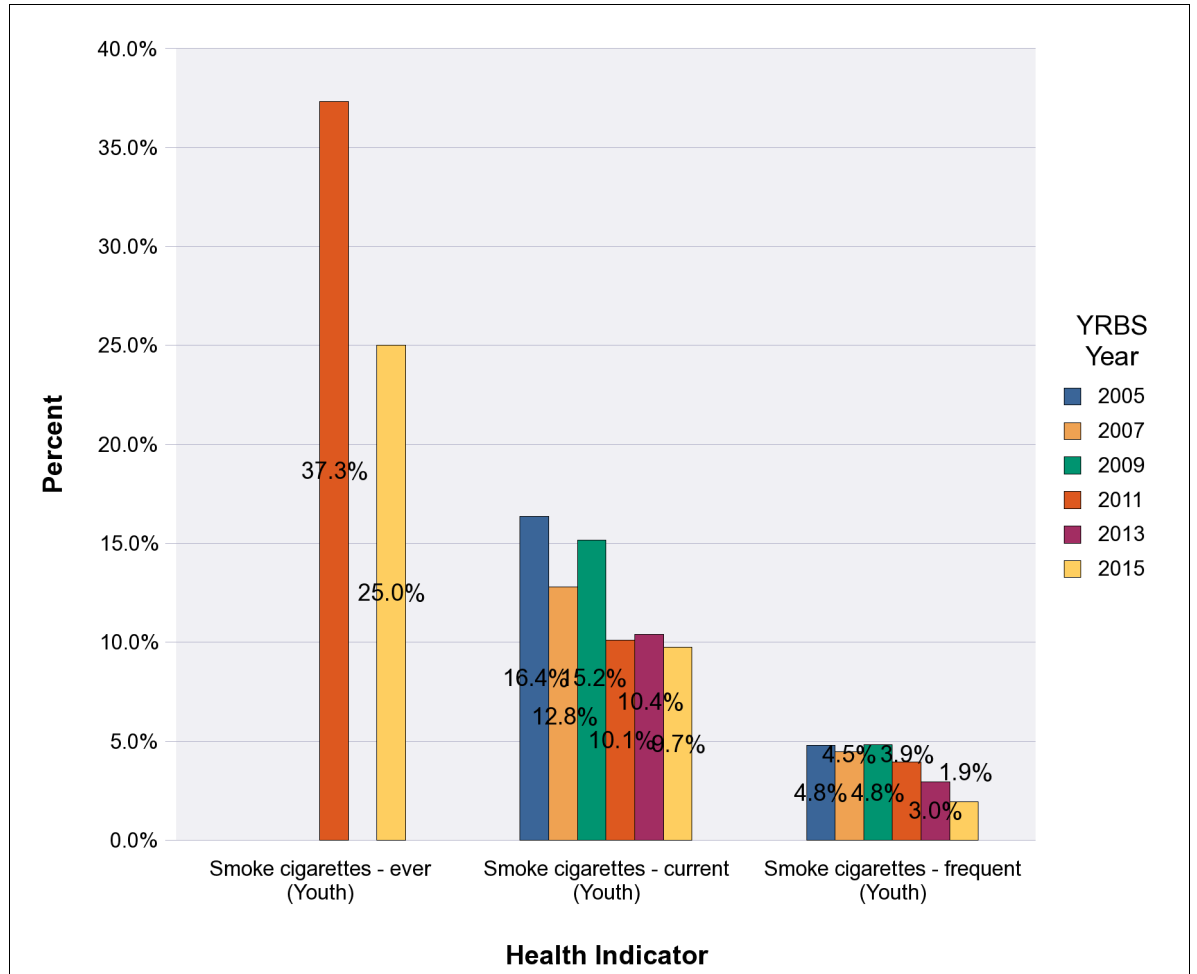

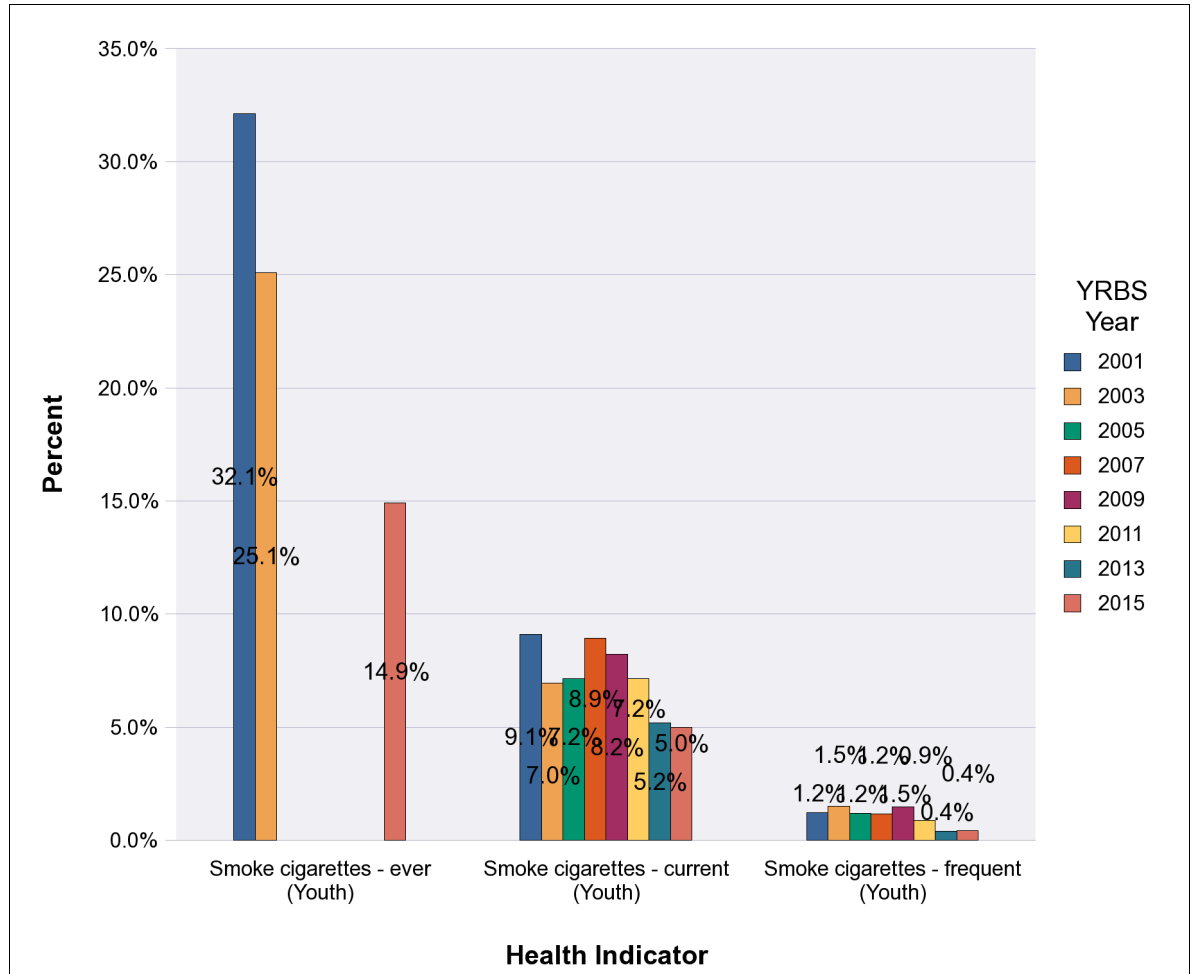


Cigarette Smoking in Hawaii, by School Type, for the Years 2001 - 2015
