Skipped school b/c felt unsafe, past 30 days (HS)	Students who did not go to school because they felt they would be unsafe at school or on their way to or from school, on one or more of the past 30 days (HS)

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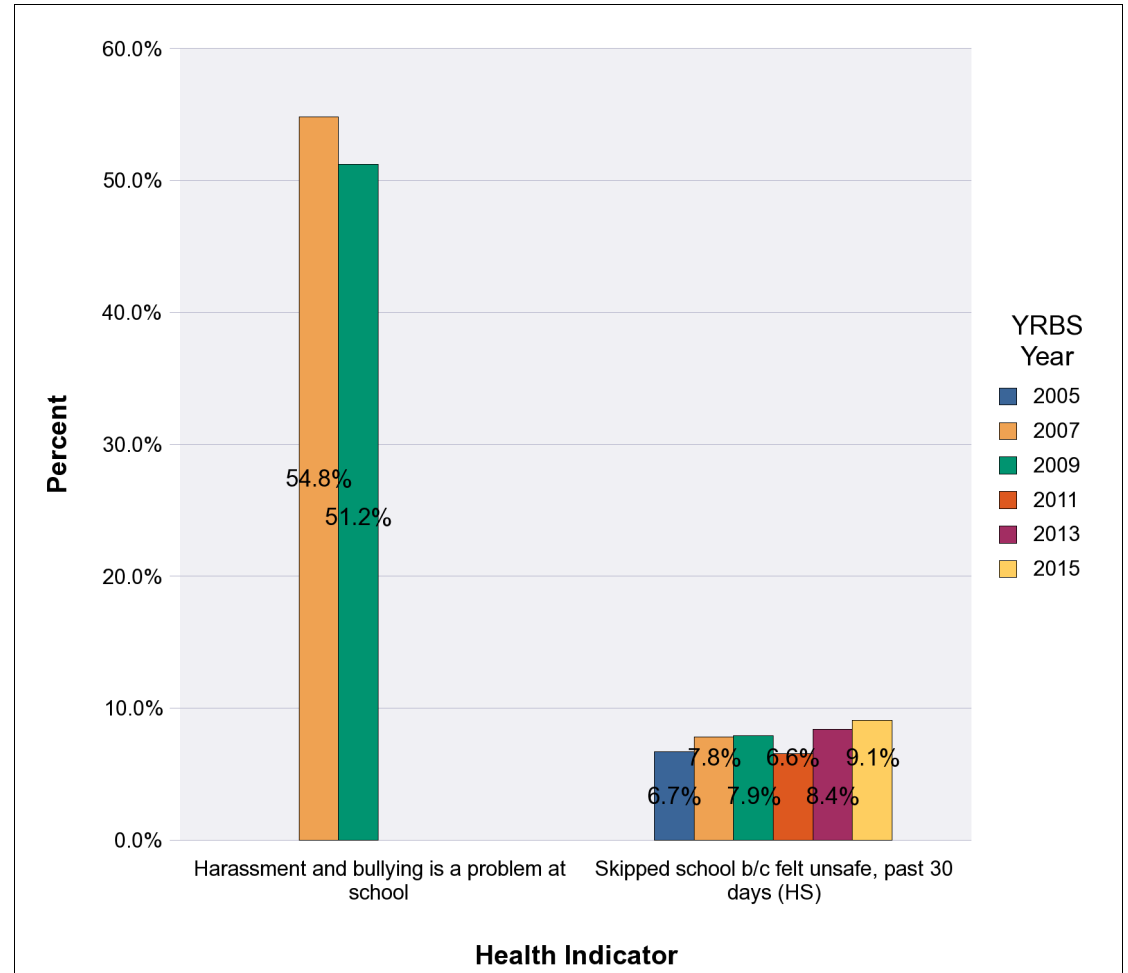

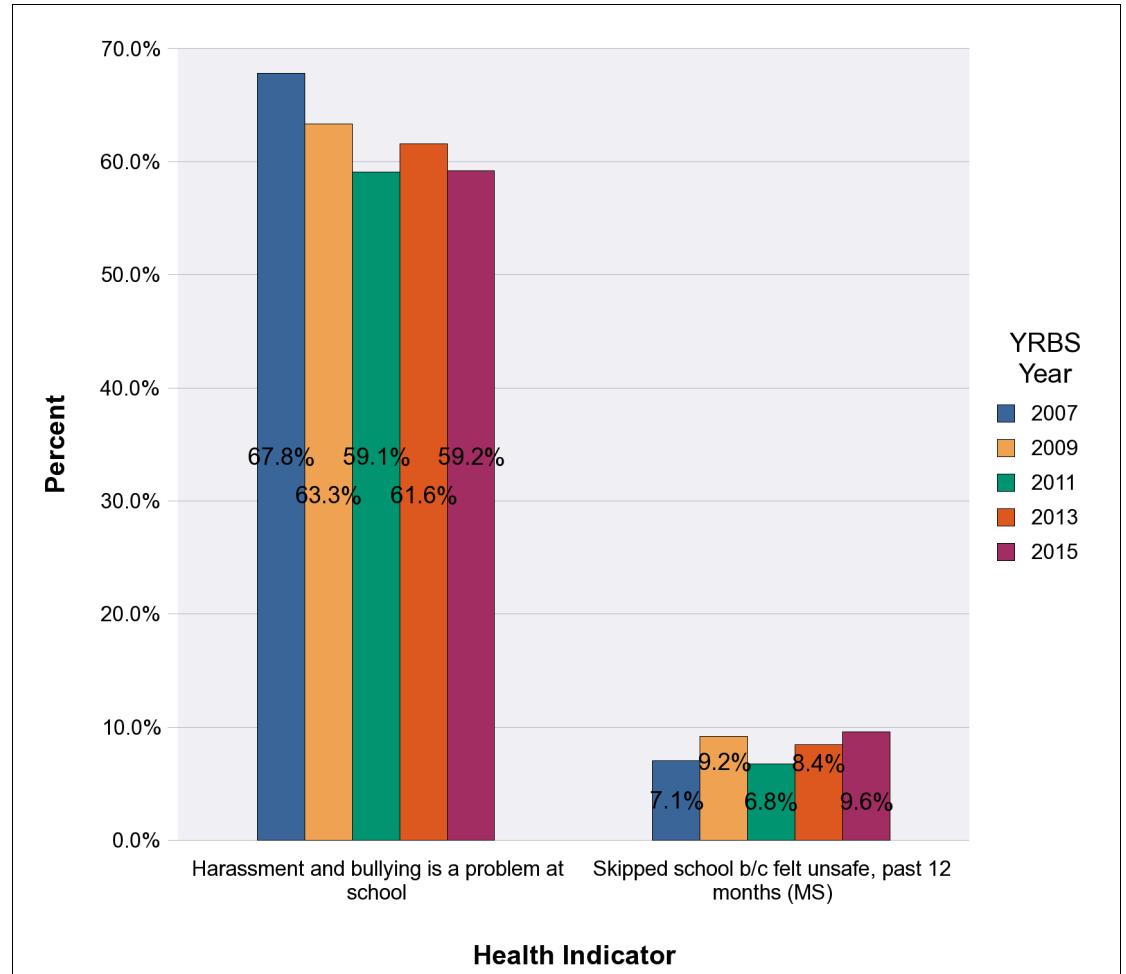


Perceived Safety at School in Hawaii, by School Type, for the Years 2005 - 2015
