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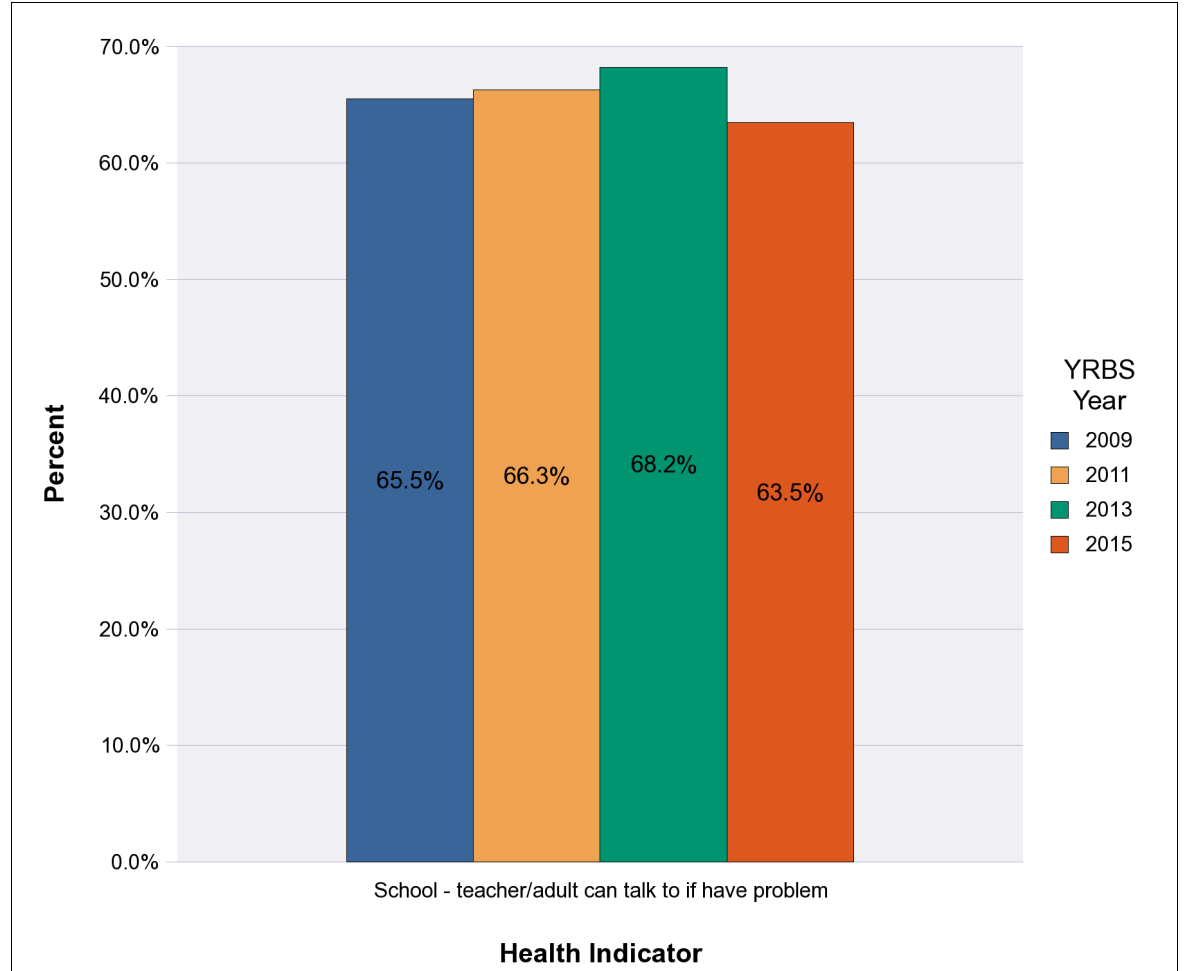

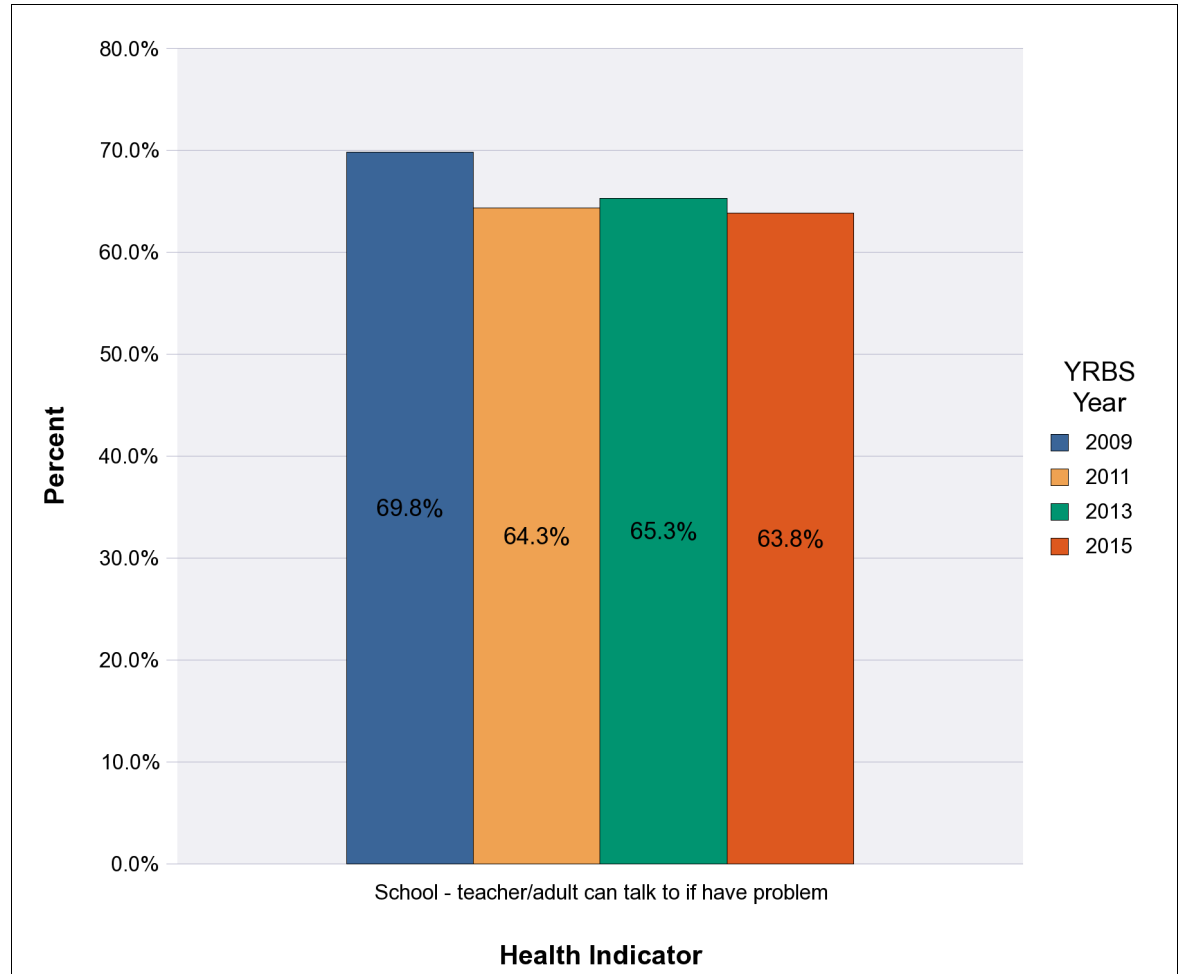


Adult Support at School in Hawaii, by School Type, for the Years 2009 - 2015
