Health Indicator	Health Indicator Description
Drug use - inject illegal drug, ever	Students who used a needle to inject any illegal drug into their body one or more times during their life
Drug use - heroin, ever	Students who have ever used heroin (also called "smack," "junk," or "China white") one or more times during their life

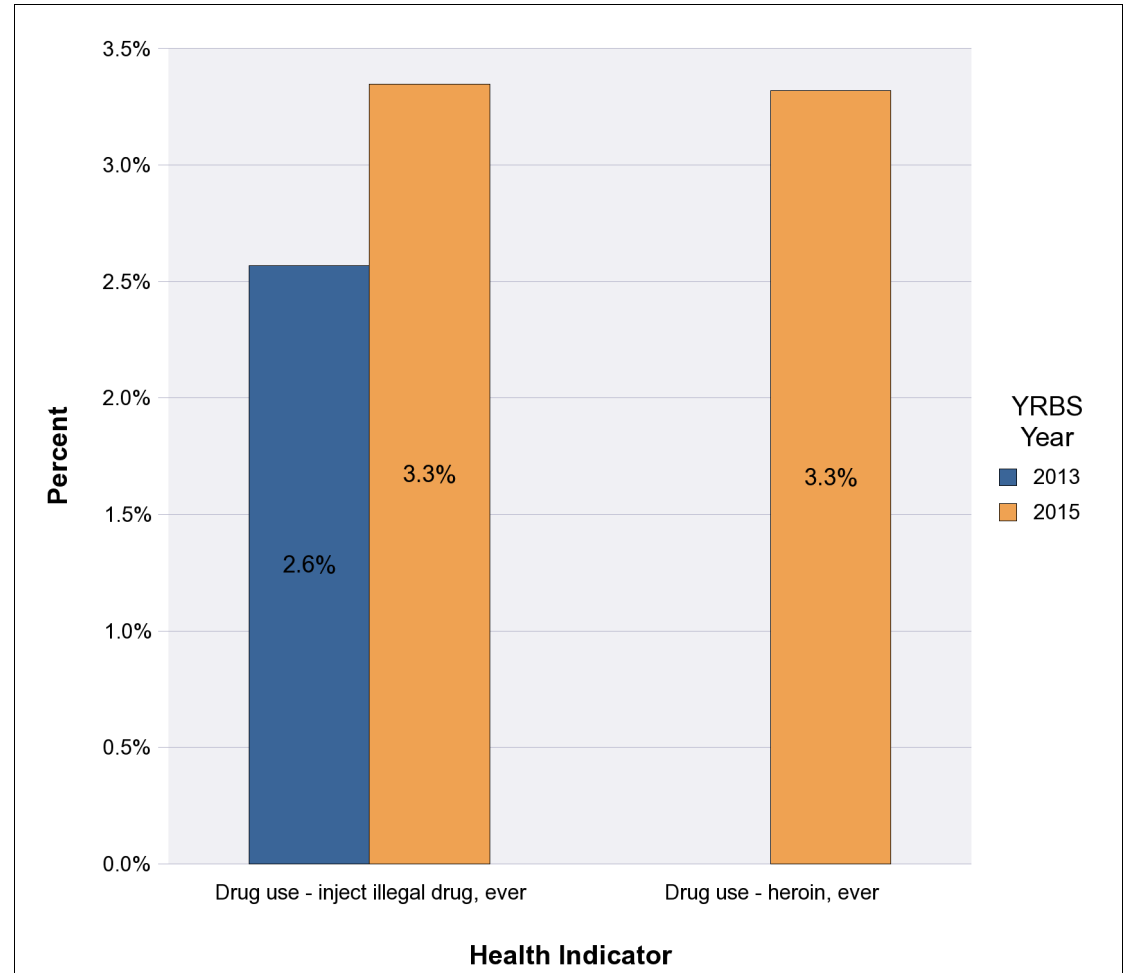
