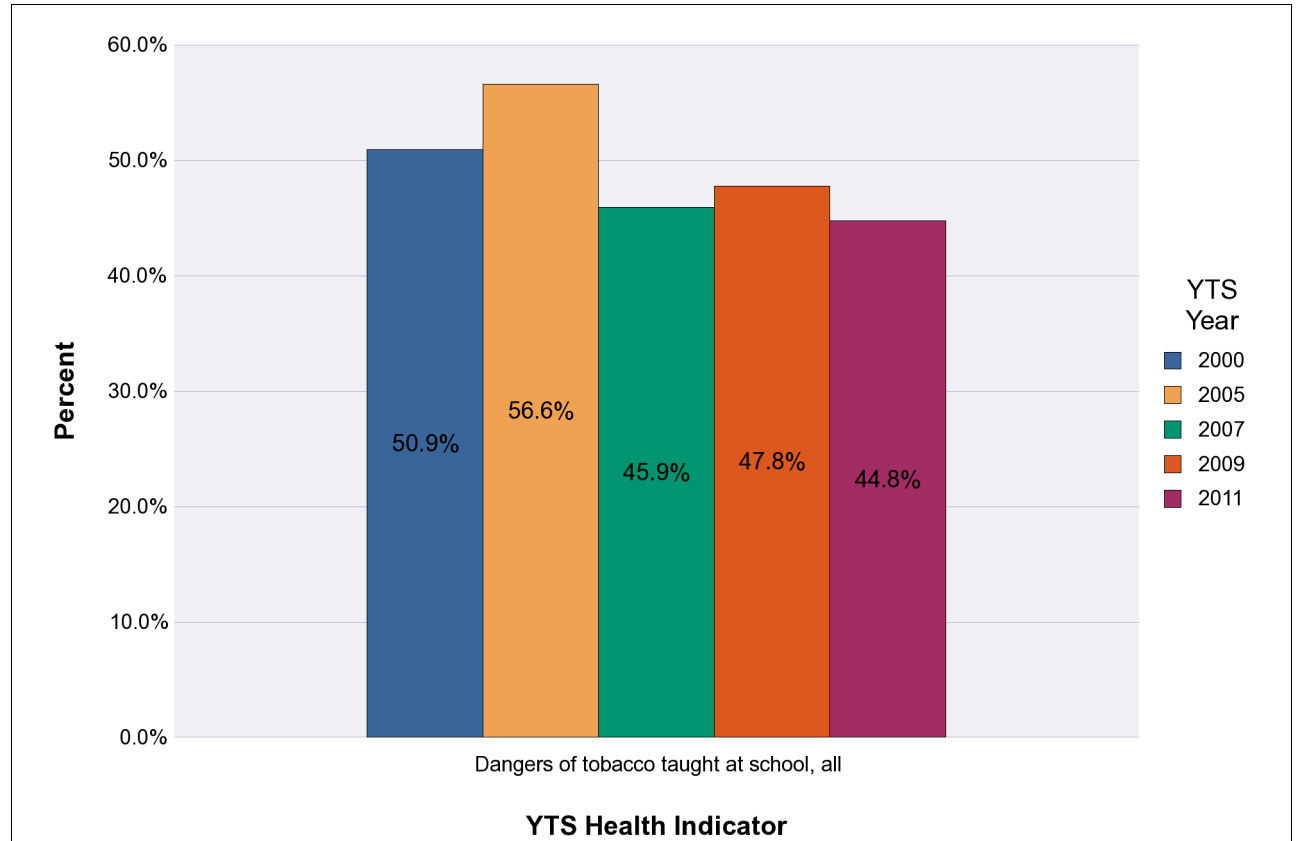

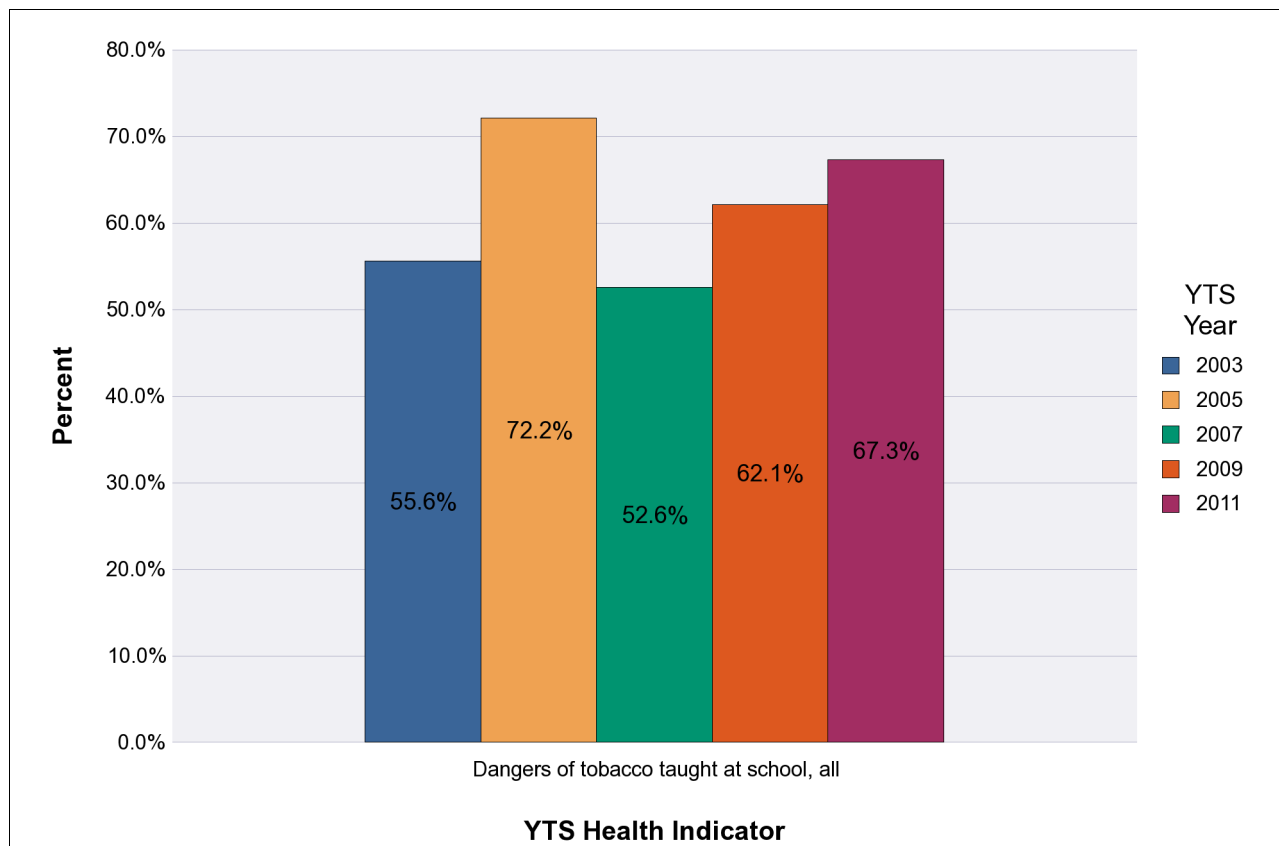


Anti-tobacco Curriculum by School Type, for the Year(s) - 2000, 2003, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2011
