### Fetal Deaths in Hawai'i

Fetal Deaths, for the State of Hawai'i (Residents Only), by Mother's State and County of Residence, Age, and DOH Race/Ethnicity and Physician's Estimate of Gestational Age for the Years 2012-2022

This report displays the number of fetal deaths and the fetal death rate per 1000 live births for Hawai'i residents. A fetal death is the spontaneous interatuerine death of a fetus at any time during pregnancy. The fetal death rate is the number fo fetal deaths per 1000 live births and fetal deaths.

Data for fetal deaths and live births come from Vital Statistics records from the Hawai'i Department of Health Office of Health Status Monitoring (DOH OHSM). The report is based on fetal deaths and births in a calendar year to women who reside in Hawaii. Since there is a lag in fetal reporting to DOH OHSM, recent numbers may vary slightly by year. Records with dimension values that are unknown are not included in the calculations. Cells with 1 to 9 fetal deaths are supressed along with rates based on fewer than 20 fetal deaths.
