### Section 1: Background and Methods


This report displays the leading causes of death for Hawai'i residents. Death record information is from the Hawai'i State Department of Health, Office of Health Status Monitoring and was compiled by the Hawai'i Health Data Warehouse at the University of Hawai'i, Department of Public Health Sciences.

Data for this report are based on information from death certificates. Causes of death are classified by the *International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision* (ICD-10), and underlying cause of death is assigned by the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS), National Vital Statistics System (NVSS) at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) according to international standards. The current report follows the methodology used by NVSS for their annual reports, which can be found <a href="here">here</a>. Leading causes of death have been aggregated based on the underlying cause of death. Causes of death are grouped into 114 selected causes of death according to NVSS standards for decedents. These are further grouped into 51 rankable causes of death. Death counts in these 51 groupings were used to generate the leading causes of death in this report. Records that are missing a cause of death were excluded from the analysis. To protect confidentiality, cells with counts between 1 and 9 have been suppressed. When this happens, fewer than 10 leading causes of death will be displayed in the pie chart or matrix.

This report includes leading causes of death among Hawai'i residents for the state by year from 2019-2023 and by county, sex, race/ethnicity, and age for 2021-2023. Causes of death for county, sex, race/ethnicity and age are presented as 3-year aggregates to ensure stability and minimize cell suppression. Residence was determined based on the census tract of the decedent. Detailed information on how residence is mapped to counties can be found <a href="here">here</a>. Race/ethnicity is reported according to the Hawai'i State Department of Health reporting algorithm which includes Hawai'i-specific race/ethnicities. More details on how decedent race/ethnicity was determined can be found <a href="here">here</a>.

This report contains two types of figures: pie charts and matrices. The pie charts include the population, year, the total number of deaths within the population during the time period, and the percent of all deaths due to the top 10 causes of death. The remaining deaths are aggregated into the "All other causes" wedge. In the sample on the right, there were 12,277 deaths in the State of Hawai'i in 2023. Heart disease was the leading cause of death accounting for 21.8% of all deaths followed by cancer (20.5%) and stroke (7.2%). The 10 leading causes of death accounted for 71.9% of all deaths (100% - 28.1% of deaths from all other causes). Causes with the same counts are tied for rank, resulting in some pie charts displaying more than 10 causes.

The matrices display the counts for the 10 leading causes of death by population with the cause of death and count in each box. When two or more causes of death have the same counts, they are tied for rank, the cells are merged, and shown in light grey with the causes listed alphabetically within the cells.





Figure 1: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death: State of Hawai'i, 2023 and 2021-2023






Figure 2: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death by County: State of Hawai'i, 2021-2023




Figure 3: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death by Sex: State of Hawai'i, 2021-2023







Figure 4: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death by Race/Ethnicity: State of Hawai'i, 2021-2023




Figure 4: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death by Race/Ethnicity: State of Hawai'i, 2021-2023





Figure 4: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death by Race/Ethnicity: State of Hawai'i, 2021-2023







Figure 5: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death by Age Group State of Hawai'i, 2021-2023

Part 1: Ages 1-9, 10-24, 25-44, and 45-64











Figure 5: Percent Distribution of the 10 Leading Causes of Death by Age Group State of Hawai'i, 2021-2023
